## AUDITION REPERTOIRE

**Auditionees should have a solo work or concerto movement of his/her choice prepared which may or may not be heard. Sight-reading from the orchestral literature will be asked of everyone. Please prepare the excerpts for your instrument listed below.**

### PRINCIPAL HORN:

Beethoven	Symphony No. 3:	third movement:Trio
Brahms	Symphony No. 2	first & second movements
Ravel	Pavane for a Dead Princess	opening solo
Shostakovich	Symphony No. 5	first movement complete including solo near end
Strauss	Till Eulenspiegel	opening solos, rehearsal 29-30
Tchaikovsky	Symphony No. 5	second movement

### THIRD TRUMPET: (Preference given to those with access to a rotary trumpet for some pieces)

Bach	Suite No. 3: Gigue (second or third)
Beethoven	Symphony No. 5: IV beginning and Presto (part of your choice) (on rotary if available)
Brahms	Academic Festival Overture (first <u>and</u> third parts)
Debussy	Nocturnes: II: Fetes (third part)
Respighi	Pines of Rome: second movement offstage solo, any part rehearsal 22 to end
Mussorgsky	Pictures at an Exhibition: opening Promenade (first)

### SECOND TROMBONE:

Mozart	Requiem: Tuba mirum (second)
Rossini	William Tell storm (first or second)
Brahms	Symphony No. 2: first mvt. rehearsal G to I, fourth mvt. rehearsal O to end (second)
Ravel	Bolero (first) solo
Stravinsky	Pulcinella: Vivo (first)
Kodaly	Hary Janos Suite: fourth movement "The Battle and Defeat of Napoleon"

### ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL BASS

Mozart	Symphony No. 40: first movement development (passage before rehearsal C)
Beethoven	Symphony No. 5: third movement
Brahms	Symphony No. 2: first & fourth movements
Ginastera	Variaciones Concertantes: section 11*

### SECTION STRINGS

Rachmaninov	Symphony No. 2: second movement
Brahms	Symphony No. 2: first and fourth movements
Those auditioning for the Assistant Principal Bass will automatically be considered (without the Rachmaninov) for the section bass position.	

### ANY INSTRUMENT FOR THE SUBLIST

Strings should prepare the Section Strings repertoire; other instrumentalists should prepare standard excerpts for their instrument. Occasionally a specific excerpt will be required for a specific instrument. Please contact David Hagy to inquire about any specific repertoire.
